TIX FOR TOTS/REFLECTIONS

Greetings friends and supporters. I'm amazed how quickly time passes and I'm sitting down to write another note for our annual report. I'm grateful in some ways for the annual passing, however, because it always provides the opportunity to reflect on our accomplishments and our plans. Better yet, I have the opportunity to share these developments with our supporters.

This report is actually a combination of two years of operations: 2009 and 2010. It's a fascinating story because it documents a troubling economic time (as it was for so many organizations), organizational adjustments and ultimately a successful recovery. Along the way, I'm proud to say that we've never wavered from our mission to keep providing kids with the opportunities so desperately needed to lift them from difficult circumstances and position them for a better future.

As 2009 unfolded, the economic environment made fundraising a difficult endeavor. While we pushed against this headwind, operations held strong, allowing us to bring in nearly 40,000 ticket opportunities while adding new venue and agency partners. So, while we were disappointed with our financial situation, we were still very excited with the momentum of our mission.

As 2010 emerged, we were faced with the fallout of the financial situation of 2009. Unabated, we continued our development efforts and found more success. Moreover, we made some strategic operational adjustments to compensate. We executed additional fundraising events, including a golf event and a formal fundraiser in conjunction with November to Remember. We raised more contributions from individuals and foundations. Most importantly, however, we implemented our first ever program fee, charged against our non-profit agency partners. The decision to add this nominal fee came after a great deal of internal discussion and evaluation. While we'd love to continue to host all agencies in our program free of charge, it was no longer economically feasible. Fortunately, these

moves helped stabilize our financial position and positioned us to move forward and strive towards our strategic goals. We've been impressed with the resiliency and open partnership displayed by our agency partners. Another notable development was the Twins' move to Target Field. While this was exciting all around, the intense demand on tickets and reduced supply made tickets difficult to come by. While we used to get tens of thousands of ticket some years, in 2010 we understandably received very few. In total we received a little over 20,000 tickets in 2010.

Moving forward in 2011 and beyond, we continued to be very excited about the potential for Tix for Tots. We are continuing to expand venue relationships, including an exciting partnership with the Twins that allows season ticket holders to donate tickets online. As we strengthen our Twin Cities operations, we are also actively exploring opportunities to expand our operations regionally. In summary, we feel blessed to have weathered a significant storm and eager to push forward to bigger and better days ahead.

As always, we know that none of this would be possible without the steadfast support of our donors and supporters and the rich partnerships of our agency and venue partners. The continual influx of tickets, financial donations, volunteer hours and operational partnership are the lifeblood of our organization. I give heartfelt thanks to the Tix for Tots board and all our partners for bringing our mission to life and for giving so much to the children in our community!

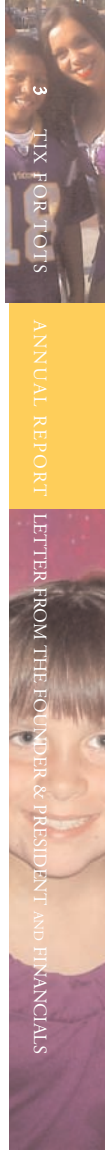

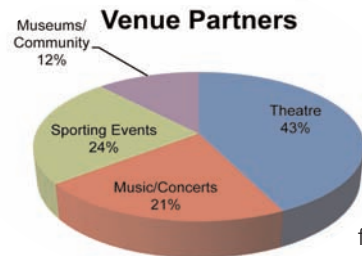
TIX FOR TOTS

Tix for Tots partners with over 150 nonprofit organizations to serve children in need throughout the Twin Cities Metro Area and Greater Minnesota and Wisconsin. Since 2001, Tix for Tots has provided over 300,000 experiences to children facing a variety of barriers and disadvantages, including homelessness, low socioeconomic status, chronic and/or long-term illness, chemical dependency, abuse, neglect, school truancy and poor academic performance.

Through Tix for Tots, individual donors, corporations, and venue partners donate unused event tickets, which are then distributed to our nonprofit partners, who ensure the tickets are given to children who are traditionally unable to afford or access such events. Our qualified management team carefully accredits nonprofit organization partners and, through the use of technology and software applications, matches up these available tickets with the appropriate partner agencies in our community.

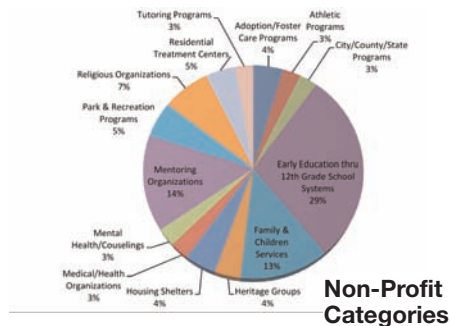
Tix for Tots works closely with its nonprofit partners to support and enhance their missions. By offering highly-anticipated, fun, and meaningful events, Tix for Tots creates

unprecedented opportunities for its partners, offering positive mentoring, respite, and incentive-based experiences that significantly improve their ability to achieve and advance their mission.



Tix for Tots also works with its venue and nonprofit partner agencies to ensure accountability and satisfaction. We track ticket requests and ticket usage rates with each of our partners to continuously improve our efficiencies. We also regularly solicit feedback from our partners and the children who attend our events to help expand capacity and overall satisfaction with our program.

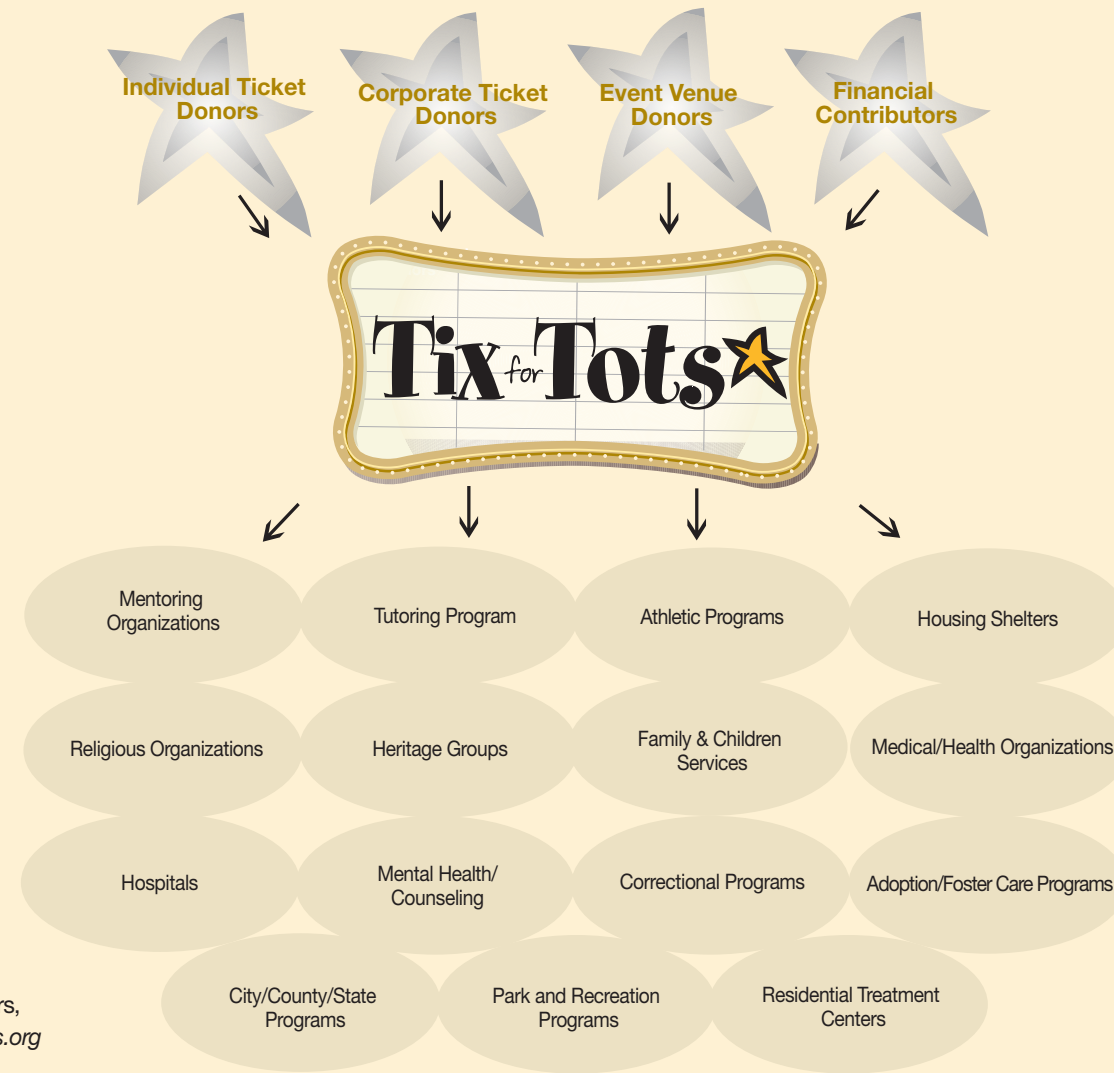
